
3.1.6.Parents-Teacher Meet




3.1.14. Farewell For Final Years (2019-2023)


3.1.16. Orientation Program on Cloud Computing






3.1.24. Industrial Visit – Birla Planetarium


3.2.1.CISCO Networking: A Comprehensive Workshop


3.2.3. Department Assembly


3.2.8. Orientation Program

3.2.15. Seminar -Barclays Lifeskills Training




5.1 Drug Awareness Program





5.7 Poster Creation




5.32 Professional Speakers Club- Speech Competition
